

Rebel Prisoners from Pilot Knob *Missouri Democrat* 16 Nov 1864 page 4 column 3

[Many Walking Wounded were taken back to Arkansas for care under the command of Col. Rainey, while other light wounded obviously went along with General Price on the rest of the raid. These are the Confederates still in the hospital when the Union took back over in October who recovered enough to go to prison. The person is named by Rank, Name and then the unit they were with. So entries read as Captain – John Smith – Monroe’s (which would mean Monroe’s Cavalry) – editor.]

Rebel Prisoners from Pilot Knob. --- The following rebel prisoners were brought up from Pilot Knob on Monday night, and sent to Alton. All of them were wounded, except two surgeons and several nurses. A few of them were quite severely wounded, and their recovery is considered doubtful:
